Project Instructions

1. The background paper is the Falala Geometric (green side) and the edges have been sanded just to distress it a little
2. Next, adhere a 2 ½" strip of Pointsetter Stripe paper to the right hand side
3. Vertically cut the Scallop Circle at 7 inches (17.5cm) across and adhere to the right hand side, touching the previous strip of paper. Lightly sand the edges taking care not to rip the paper!
4. Distress the edges of your 6x4 photograph with a distressing tool or sanding block and then ink with Tim Holtz Distress Ink Pad in Antique Linen. Place the photo to the right of your page at a slight angle.
5. Stamp Autumn Leaves Flourishes v2 in Staz-on Olive Green ink above and below the photograph where the edge of the scallop circle/strip of paper join.
6. Cut the number 24 from the number paper and mount on foam pads to the right of the photograph with a stamped frame if desired (the one used here is a [Prima Stamp](#))
7. Highlight the number 24 in the Fired Brick Distress Stickles glitter glue and outline the embellishment in Vintage Photo Distress Stickles
8. Add Peeled Paint Stickles detail to the stamped flourishes
9. Adhere an inked blossom beneath the 24 (here Antique Linen inkpad was used)
10. Tear a 1 x 5 inch (2.5 x 12.5 cm) strip of the Music Note paper, screw up, sand and ink in Antique Linen to distress and place beneath the photograph for your handwritten title/or journaling.
11. Add a torn thin strip of the same paper but the reverse side beneath this
12. Complete your title with [letter stickers](#). Outline stickers in black for definition.
